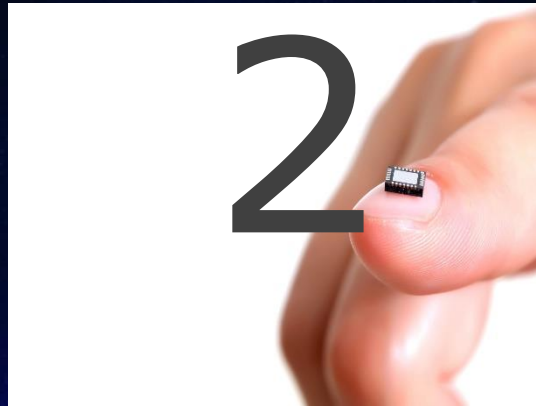

Building a team

Building a Team – of a minimum of 3!

- **Minimum requirements for collaborations:**
3 partners from 3 different EU countries or AC
- Match participants with topic
- Defined role of each group
- Synergy between the groups
- Partners known to deliver
- Balance between sectors

- Explain your idea clearly
- Argue your case
- Tap into your network
- Spread the word
- Check out past EU projects in the domain of your targeted call

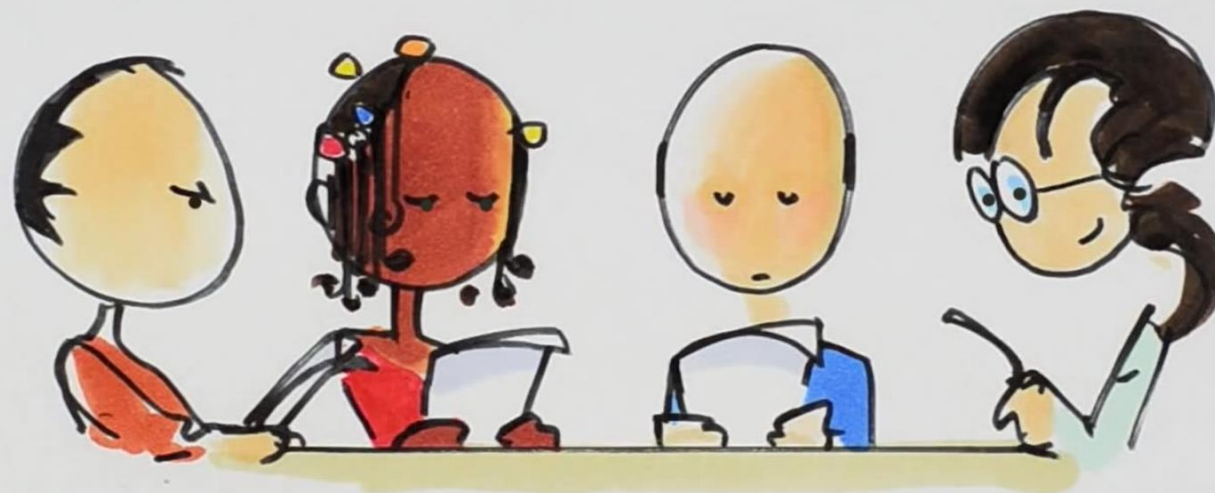


How to join a consortium – as a partner

- Participate in brokerage events.

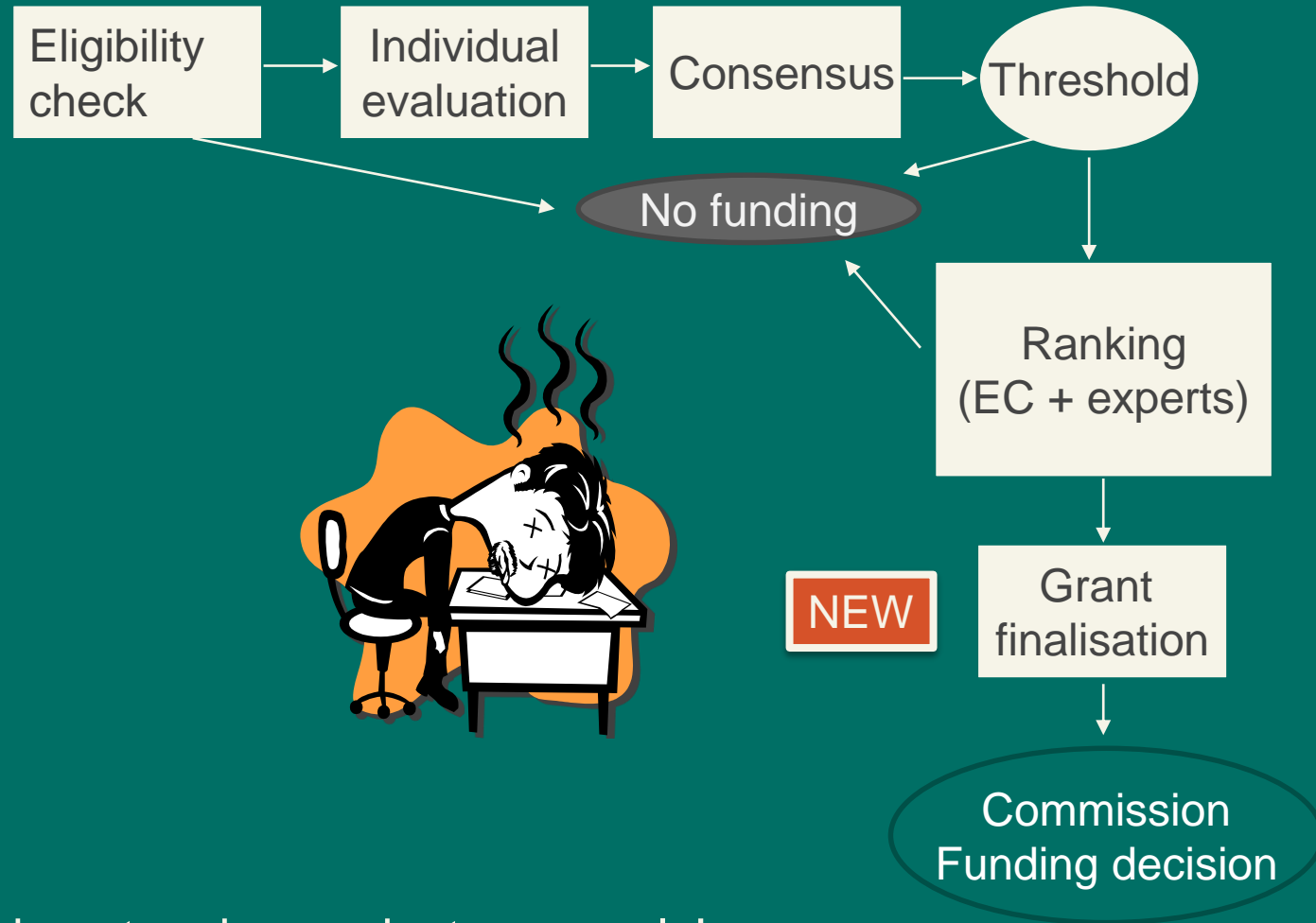
