


Horisont 2020 består av tre delar:

Building a team

- **Minimum requirements for collaborations:**

3 partners from 3 different EU countries or AC

- Match participants with topic
- Defined role of each group
- Synergy between the groups
- Partners known to deliver
- Balance between sectors



How to build a winning consortium – as a coordinator


- Explain your idea clearly




How to join a consortium – as a partner

- Participate in brokerage events.




